Subject: Regarding Minutes of Pre-Application Meeting and the corresponding Addendum issued for the Initial Selection of Design, Build and Operate (DBO) Contract for Reconstruction, Expansion and Operation of Pagla Sewage Treatment Plant (Package No.: WD1) held on 12 January, 2021 under Dhaka Sanitation Improvement Project (DSIP), Dhaka WASA.

A Pre-Application Meeting for the Initial Selection of Design, Build and Operate (DBO) Contract for Reconstruction, Expansion and Operation of Pagla Sewage Treatment Plant (Package No.: WD1) was held at 1630 hours Bangladesh Local Time (GMT+6) on January 12, 2021 at the Dhaka WASA Conference Center as per the ITA clause No.-7.2. The meeting was also connected virtually. Some of the prospective applicants as well as the consultant attended the meeting virtually. The meeting was presided over by Md. Abul Kashem, Director (Development), Dhaka WASA and Mohd. Akhtaruzzaman, Addl. Chief Engineer (RP&D), Dhaka WASA and PMU officials attended the meeting. A list of the attendees is attached herewith as **Annexure-A**.

At the beginning, the Chairperson welcomed all and he stated that Dhaka WASA is currently planning to bring the whole city area into a planned sanitation system. He also added that Dhaka WASA is planning to construct/reconstruct five STPs within the core area of Dhaka City. Reconstruction and expansion of Pagla STP is one of them.

Taking the floor, Mohd Akhtaruzzaman, Addl. Chief Engineer (RP&D) confirmed both on-line and off-line participants of the meeting by calling out the names of the companies who purchased the Initial Selection Document (ISD). Two other relevant Dhaka WASA officers Mohammad Salim Miah, Executive Engineer, DSIP and Mahbub Ul Alam Mohammad Jamal, Executive Engineer, DSIP also introduced themselves to all the participants of the meeting.

The Chairperson then requested Md. Rafiqul Islam, Project Director, Dhaka Sanitation Improvement Project (DSIP), Dhaka WASA to give a brief introduction on the agenda of the meeting. Taking the floor, Md. Rafiqul Islam briefly explained the background of the Project as well as the financial arrangement and procurement regulation of this initial selection. He also added that the project is jointly funded by the World Bank, Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) and the Government of Bangladesh and all the procedures and method of the procurement will be undertaken as per the procurement regulation/guidelines of the World Bank along with Bangladesh local rules. The Project Director also expressed the expectation for the submission of applications from all the participants in the meeting.

The Project Director then requested the Consultant, who prepared the conceptual design and procurement document of this package, to give a brief presentation on the ISD of this package. It may be mentioned here that the Consultant attended the meeting virtually and taking the floor the Consultant expressed their gratitude to Dhaka WASA for the invitation to the meeting.

Presentation by the Consultant


- The Consultant delivered a brief presentation to explain the contents of ISD to all participants of the meeting.

- Prior to the presentation, the Consultant emphasized that the ISD will govern when there are any discrepancy between ISD and presentation
- Summary of initial selection including project name, RFP name, Client and scope of work was presented to all the participants.
- Current conditions of the existing Pagla STP was briefly explained with some of the photographs taken during the conceptual design stage.
- The Consultant explained the Performance requirement of the facilities briefly including capacity, process, characteristic of dewatered sludge, on-site power generation, and septage treatment.
- Total contract period of the Project will be 112 months including 40 months of Design and Build, 12 months of Defects Liability Period and 60 months of Operation Services.
- At the end of the presentation, the Consultant explained the eligibility/qualification and rated criteria for the evaluation as identical to ISD.
- The Consultant ended the presentation with appreciation to Dhaka WASA officers and all the participants to the meeting.

Question and Answer from the Prospective Applicants: The floor was opened and the Project Director invited all the participants to put their queries and he also requested to submit the queries through e-mail on or before 14th January 2021 5:00 p.m. (BST). Dhaka WASA's written response to the prospective applicant's queries will be prepared and issued.

As there was no other points, the meeting was ended with vote of thanks by the Chair.
